
Graniteshares 3x Long Nio Daily Etc (Fri, Jun 28, 2024)

Tech commentaries:

The **Graniteshares 3x Long Nio Daily Etc** ETF price fell by **-22.38%** on the last day (Friday, 28th Jun 2024) from **£0.625** to **£0.485**. During the last trading day the ETF fluctuated **14.23%** from a day low at **£0.475** to a day high of **£0.543**. The price has fallen in 5 of the last 10 days and is down by **-17.99%** for this period. Volume has increased on the last day by **27 thousand** shares but on falling prices. This may be an early warning and the risk will be increased slightly over the next couple of days. In total, **27** thousand shares were bought and sold for approximately **£13.02** thousand.

The ETF lies in the lower of a very wide and falling trend in the short term, and this may normally pose a very good buying opportunity. If the lower trend floor at £0.407 is broken, it will firstly indicate a stronger fall rate. Given the current short-term trend, the ETF is expected to fall **-6.39%** during the next 3 months and, with a 90% probability hold a price between **£0.381** and **£1.24** at the end of this 3-month period.

There are few to no technical positive signals at the moment. The **Graniteshares 3x Long Nio Daily Etc** ETF holds sell signals from both short and long-term Moving Averages giving a more negative forecast for the stock. Also, there is a general sell signal from the relation between the two signals where the long-term average is above the short-term average. On corrections up, there will be some resistance from the lines at £0.555 and £0.87. A break-up above any of these levels will issue buy signals. A sell signal was issued from a pivot top point on **Tuesday, May 14, 2024**, and so far it has fallen -64.59%. Further fall is indicated until a new bottom pivot has been found. Furthermore, there is currently a sell signal from the 3 month Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD). **Graniteshares 3x Long Nio Daily Etc** gained volume on the last day, but on falling prices. In technical terms, this is called divergence and may be an early warning. In some cases, increasing volume on falling prices may be considered positive, but that is mainly in typical "sell-offs". The very low volume increases the risk and reduces the other technical signals issued.

Graniteshares 3x Long Nio Daily Etc finds support from accumulated volume at £0.481 and this level may hold a buying opportunity as an upwards reaction can be expected when the support is being tested. On the upside the ETF meets some resistance from accumulated volume at £0.539, £0.572 and £0.592.

This ETF may move very much during the day (volatility) and with a very large prediction interval from the Bollinger Band this ETF is considered to be "very high risk". During the last day, the ETF moved £0.0676 between high and low, or 14.23%. For the last week, the ETF has had daily average volatility of 9.76%.

Graniteshares 3x Long Nio Daily Etc holds several negative signals and this should be a sell candidate, but due to the general chance for a turnaround situation it should be considered as a hold candidate (hold or accumulate) in this position whilst awaiting further development. We have upgraded our analysis conclusion for this ETF since the last evaluation from a Sell to a Hold/Accumulate candidate.
