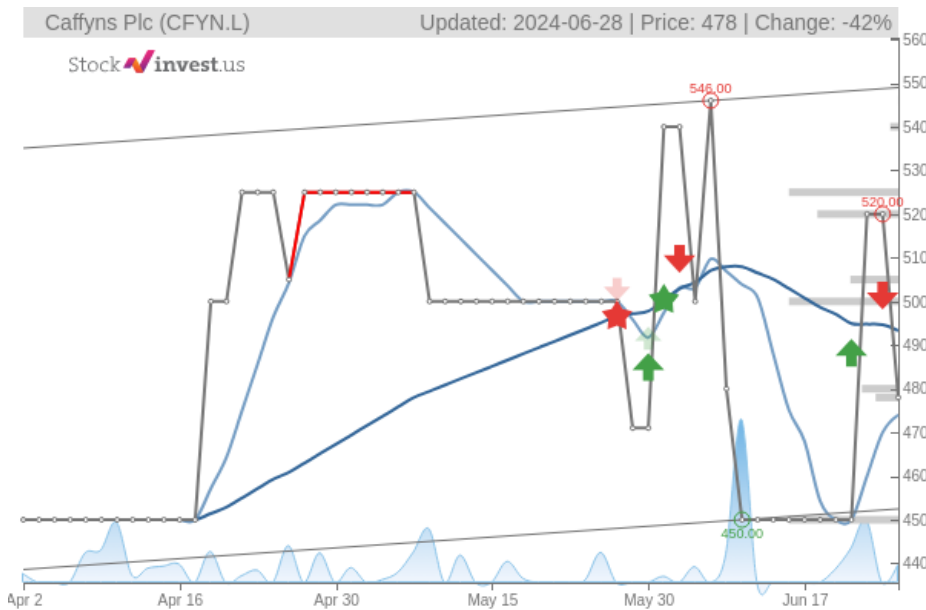


Caffyns Plc (Fri, Jun 28, 2024)

Tech commentaries:

The **Caffyns Plc** stock price fell by **-8.08%** on the last day (Friday, 28th Jun 2024) from **£520.00** to **£478.00**. During the last trading day the stock fluctuated **0%** from a day low at **£478.00** to a day high of **£478.00**. The price has been going up and down for this period, and there has been a 6.22% gain for the last 2 weeks. Volume has increased on the last day by **700** shares but on falling prices. This may be an early warning and the risk will be increased slightly over the next couple of days. In total, **700** shares were bought and sold for approximately **£334.60** thousand.

The stock lies in the middle of a wide and weak rising trend in the short term and a further rise within the trend is signaled. Given the current short-term trend, the stock is expected to rise **2.59%** during the next 3 months and, with a 90% probability hold a price between **£464.21** and **£563.21** at the end of this 3-month period.

There are few to no technical positive signals at the moment. The **Caffyns Plc** stock holds a buy signal from the short-term Moving Average; at the same time, however, the long-term average holds a general sell signal. Since the long-term average is above the short-term average there is a general sell signal in the stock giving a more negative forecast for the stock. On further gains, the stock will meet resistance from the long-term Moving Average at **£493.31**. On a fall, the stock will find some support from the short-term average at **£474.00**. A break-up through the long-term average will give another buy signal, while a fall below the short-term average will add another sell signal and strengthen the general signal. A sell signal was issued from a pivot top point on **Thursday, June 27, 2024**, and so far it has fallen -8.08%. Further fall is indicated until a new bottom pivot has been found. Furthermore, there is currently a sell signal from the 3 month Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD). **Caffyns Plc** gained volume on the last day, but on falling prices. In technical terms, this is called divergence and may be an early warning. In some cases, increasing volume on falling prices may be considered positive, but that is mainly in typical "sell-offs".

Caffyns Plc finds support from accumulated volume at **£471.00** and this level may hold a buying opportunity as an upwards reaction can be expected when the support is being tested. On the upside the stock meets some resistance just above today's level from accumulated volume at **£500.00**, **£520.00** and **£525.00**.

This stock may move much during the day (volatility) and with a large prediction interval from the Bollinger Band this stock is considered to be "high risk". During the last day, the stock moved **£0** between high and low, or **0%**. For the last week, the stock has had daily average volatility of **6.06%**.

Caffyns Plc holds several negative signals and this should be a sell candidate, but due to the general chance for a turnaround situation it should be considered as a hold candidate (hold or accumulate) in this position whilst awaiting further development. We have upgraded our analysis conclusion for this stock since the last evaluation from a Sell to a Hold/Accumulate candidate.
