## **Tech commentaries:**

The Pimco Etfs Plc Pimco Euro Short Maturity ETF price gained 0.0020% on the last trading day (Friday, 28th Jun 2024), rising from 97.98€ to 97.98€ It has now gained 3 days in a row. It will be exciting to see whether it manages to continue gaining or take a minor break for the next few days. During the last trading day the ETF fluctuated 0.0490% from a day low at 97.98€to a day high of 98.02€ The price has risen in 7 of the last 10 days but is still down by -0.22% for this period. Volume has increased on the last day along with the price, which is a positive technical sign, and, in total, 1 thousand more shares were traded than the day before. In total, 4 thousand shares were bought and sold for approximately 376.33€thousand.

The ETF is moving within a narrow and horizontal trend and further movements within this trend can be expected. Given the current horizontal trend, you can expect Pimco Etfs Plc Pimco Euro Short Maturity ETF with a 90% probability to be traded between 98.04€ and 98.40€ at the end of this 3-month period. A break of a horizontal trend is often followed by a large increase in the volume, and ETFS seldom manage to go directly from the bottom of a trend up to the top. ETFS turning up in the middle of a horizontal trend are therefore considered to be potential runners.

A buy signal was issued from a pivot bottom point on Thursday, June 20, 2024, and so far it has risen 0.131%. Further rise is indicated until a new top pivot has been found. Pimco Etfs Plc Pimco Euro Short Maturity has increased volume and follows the last lift in the price. This is considered to be a technical positive sign as volume should follow the price-formation. Higher liquidity also reduces the general risk. Some negative signals were issued as well, and these may have some influence on the near short-term development. The Pimco Etfs Plc Pimco Euro Short Maturity ETF holds a buy signal from the short-term Moving Average; at the same time, however, the long-term average holds a general sell signal. Since the longterm average is above the short-term average there is a general sell signal in the ETF giving a more negative forecast for the stock. On further gains, the ETF will meet resistance from the long-term Moving Average at 98.03€ On a fall, the ETF will find some support from the short-term average at 97.93€ A break-up through the long-term average will give another buy signal, while a fall below the short-term average will add another sell signal and strengthen the general signal. Furthermore, there is currently a sell signal from the 3 month Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD).

Pimco Etfs Plc Pimco Euro Short Maturity finds support from accumulated volume at 97.96€ and this level may hold a buying opportunity as an upwards reaction can be expected when the support is being tested. On the upside the ETF meets some resistance just above today's level from accumulated volume at 98.09€ 98.11€ and 98.21€

In general the ETF tends to have very controlled movements and with good liquidity the risk is considered very low in this stock. During the last day, the ETF moved 0.0480€ between high and low, or 0.0490%. For the last week the ETF has had daily average volatility of 0.0715%.

Pimco Etfs Plc Pimco Euro Short Maturity holds several positive signals, but we still don't find these to be enough for a buy candidate. At the current level, it should be considered as a hold candidate (hold or accumulate) in this position whilst awaiting further development. Due to some small weaknesses in the technical picture we have downgraded our analysis conclusion for this ETF since the last evaluation from a Buy to a Hold/Accumulate candidate.
