Tech commentaries:

The SPDR Portfolio S&P 500 High Dividend ETF price gained 0.85% on the last trading day (Friday, 28th Jun 2024), rising from \$39.89 to \$40.23. During the last trading day the ETF fluctuated 0.650% from a day low at \$39.99 to a day high of \$40.25. The price has been going up and down for this period, and there has been a -0.05% loss for the last 2 weeks. Volume has increased on the last day along with the price, which is a positive technical sign, and, in total, 450 thousand more shares were traded than the day before. In total, 1 million shares were bought and sold for approximately \$41.77 million.

The ETF lies in the middle of a weak rising trend in the short term and a further rise within the trend is signaled. Given the current short-term trend, the ETF is expected to rise 2.64% during the next 3 months and, with a 90% probability hold a price between **\$40.01** and **\$43.01** at the end of this 3-month period.

A buy signal was issued from a pivot bottom point on Wednesday, May 29, 2024, and so far it has risen 1.77%. Further rise is indicated until a new top pivot has been found. Furthermore, there is a buy signal from the 3 month Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD). Volume is rising along with the price. This is considered to be a good technical signal. Some negative signals were issued as well, and these may have some influence on the near short-term development. The SPDR Portfolio S&P 500 High Dividend ETF holds a buy signal from the short-term Moving Average; at the same time, however, the long-term average holds a general sell signal. Since the longterm average is above the short-term average there is a general sell signal in the ETF giving a more negative forecast for the stock. On further gains, the ETF will meet resistance from the long-term Moving Average at \$40.53. On a fall, the ETF will find some support from the short-term average at \$40.20. A break-up through the long-term average will give another buy signal, while a fall below the short-term average will add another sell signal and strengthen the general signal.

SPDR Portfolio S&P 500 High Dividend finds support from accumulated volume at \$40.01 and this level may hold a buying opportunity as an upwards reaction can be expected when the support is being tested. On the upside the ETF meets some resistance just above today's level from accumulated volume at \$40.30, \$40.34 and \$40.43.

In general the ETF tends to have very controlled movements and with good liquidity the risk is considered very low in this stock. During the last day, the ETF moved \$0.260 between high and low, or 0.650%. For the last week the ETF has had daily average volatility of 0.96%.

Several short-term signals, along with a general good trend, are positive and we conclude that the current level may hold a buying opportunity as there is a fair chance for SPDR Portfolio S&P 500 High Dividend ETF to perform well in the short-term.
