## **Tech commentaries:**

The United States 12 Month Natural Gas Fund, ETF price fell by -3.55% on the last day (Friday, 24th May 2024) from \$8.74 to \$8.43. During the last trading day the ETF fluctuated 1.78% from a day low at \$8.43 to a day high of \$8.58. The price has risen in 6 of the last 10 days and is up by 6.57% over the past 2 weeks. Volume has increased on the last day by 16 thousand shares but on falling prices. This may be an early warning and the risk will be increased slightly over the next couple of days. In total, 57 thousand shares were bought and sold for approximately \$482.68 thousand.

The ETF lies in the middle of a wide and weak rising trend in the short term and a further rise within the trend is signaled. Given the current short-term trend, the ETF is expected to rise 4.23% during the next 3 months and, with a 90% probability hold a price between \$8.17 and \$9.21 at the end of this 3-month period.

The United States 12 Month Natural Gas Fund, ETF holds a sell signal from the short-term Moving Average; at the same time, however, there is a buy signal from the long-term average. Since the short-term average is above the long-term average there is a general buy signal in the ETF giving a positive forecast for the stock. On further gains, the ETF will meet resistance from the short-term Moving Average at approximately \$8.55. On a fall, the ETF will find some support from the long-term average at approximately \$8.05. A break-up through the short-term average will send a buy signal, whereas a breakdown through the longterm average will send a sell signal. Furthermore, there is a buy signal from the 3 month Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD). Some negative signals were issued as well, and these may have some influence on the near short-term development. A sell signal was issued from a pivot top point on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, and so far it has fallen -4.42%. Further fall is indicated until a new bottom pivot has been found. United States 12 Month Natural Gas Fund, gained volume on the last day, but on falling prices. In technical terms, this is called divergence and may be an early warning. In some cases, increasing volume on falling prices may be considered positive, but that is mainly in typical "sell-offs".

United States 12 Month Natural Gas Fund, finds support from accumulated volume at \$8.27 and this level may hold a buying opportunity as an upwards reaction can be expected when the support is being tested. On the upside the ETF meets some resistance just above today's level from accumulated volume at \$8.49, \$8.61 and \$8.74.

This ETF has average movements during the day and with good trading volume, the risk is considered to be medium. During the last day, the ETF moved \$0.150 between high and low, or 1.78%. For the last week, the ETF has had daily average volatility of 2.64%.

United States 12 Month Natural Gas Fund, holds several negative signals and we believe that it will still perform weakly in the next couple of days or weeks. We, therefore, hold a negative evaluation of this ETF. Due to some small weaknesses in the technical picture we have downgraded our analysis conclusion for this ETF since the last evaluation from a Buy to a Sell candidate.
