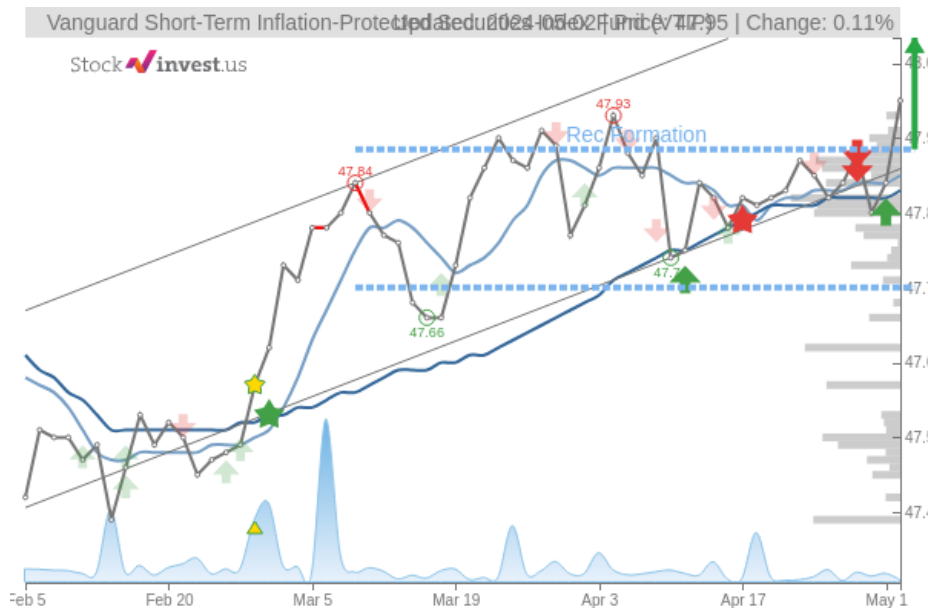


Vanguard Short-Term Inflation-Protected Securities Index Fund (Thu,

Tech commentaries:

The **Vanguard Short-Term Inflation-Protected** ETF price gained **0.230%** on the last trading day (Thursday, 2nd May 2024), rising from **\$47.84** to **\$47.95**. During the last trading day the ETF fluctuated **0.167%** from a day low at **\$47.88** to a day high of **\$47.96**. The price has risen in 7 of the last 10 days and is up by **0.29%** over the past 2 weeks. Volume fell on the last day by - **251 thousand** shares and in total, **582 thousand** shares were bought and sold for approximately **\$27.91** million. You should take into consideration that falling volume on higher prices causes divergence and may be an early warning about possible changes over the next couple of days.

The ETF is moving within a narrow and horizontal trend and further movements within this trend can be expected. Given the current horizontal trend, you can expect **Vanguard Short-Term Inflation-Protected** ETF with a 90% probability to be traded between **\$48.31** and **\$48.58** at the end of this 3-month period. A break of a horizontal trend is often followed by a large increase in the volume, and ETFS seldom manage to go directly from the bottom of a trend up to the top. ETFS turning up in the middle of a horizontal trend are therefore considered to be potential runners.

Mostly positive signals in the chart today. The **Vanguard Short-Term Inflation-Protected** ETF holds buy signals from both short and long-term Moving Averages giving a positive forecast for the stock. Also, there is a general buy signal from the relation between the two signals where the short-term average is above the long-term average. On corrections down, there will be some support from the lines at **\$47.85** and **\$47.83**. A breakdown below any of these levels will issue sell signals. A buy signal was issued from a pivot bottom point on **Wednesday, April 10, 2024**, and so far it has risen 0.440%. Further rise is indicated until a new top pivot has been found. Furthermore, there is a buy signal from the 3 month Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD). Volume fell during the last trading day despite gaining prices. This causes a divergence between volume and price and it may be an early warning. The ETF should be watched closely.

Vanguard Short-Term Inflation-Protected finds support from accumulated volume at **\$47.82** and this level may hold a buying opportunity as an upwards reaction can be expected when the support is being tested. There is no resistance from accumulated volume above today's level and given the right condition the ETF may perform very well during the next couple of days.

In general the ETF tends to have very controlled movements and with good liquidity the risk is considered very low in this stock. During the last day, the ETF moved **\$0.0800** between high and low, or **0.167%**. For the last week the ETF has had daily average volatility of **0.151%**.

Several short-term signals are positive and we conclude that the current level may hold a buying opportunity, as there is a fair chance for **Vanguard Short-Term Inflation-Protected** ETF to perform well in the short-term period.
